

Regulations of the scholarship programme
of the Faculty of Economic Sciences of the University of Warsaw (WNE)
for doctoral students of the Interdisciplinary Doctoral School (MSD)
at the University of Warsaw pursuing the Quantitative Analysis (QA) study track

1. It is envisaged to provide an increase of the doctoral scholarship for participants of the QA study track.
2. The scholarship increase is available to an MSD student who has submitted a declaration of joining the Quantitative Analysis (QA) study track, provided that:
 - a. student has got credit for all courses envisaged in the QA study track;
 - b. student had obtained a positive mid-term evaluation.
3. The scholarship increase is granted for an academic year and paid on a monthly basis at the amount of PLN 1000 per month.
4. The scholarship increase can be paid from the fifth to the eighth semester of education at MSD, for no longer than 24 months.
5. The scholarship increase is financed from the funds of WNE and is awarded independently of other benefits and scholarships received by the doctoral student.
6. The scholarship increase shall be suspended if the doctoral student:
 - a. has violated universal ethical principles and/or standards of academic integrity;
 - b. has failed to attend classes as required by the MSD programme of study;
 - c. has not fulfilled his/her teaching obligations;
 - d. in the judgement of the supervisors and the QA study track coordinator, has not demonstrated sufficient progress in his/her research work.
7. The right to receive a scholarship increase expires in cases of:
 - a. a student's resignation from realisation of QA study track or his/her removal from the list of the MSD doctoral students;
 - b. termination by the doctoral student of the cooperation with the supervisor(s) from WNE or the Faculty of Mathematics, Informatics and Mechanics, when as a result of the change of supervisor(s), none of his/her supervisors is a member of one of these faculties.
8. In addition to the scholarship increase, WNE covers the costs of participation in a training course or a workshop organised by a renowned foreign institution. Participation in the course requires the approval of the supervisors, the QA study track coordinator and the MSD Director. The maximum amount of funding is PLN 15,000 per PhD student for the entire period of study. The expenses that are covered include: the course fee and any travel, accommodation and per diem costs.
